<b>Kite Flying</b>	<b>Bill Burton</b>
Annual event for Alpine kids of all ages. Club provides kites and knowledgeable assistance on how to get the kites flying high.	

<b>Rady Children's Hospital Miracle Mile of Quarters</b>	<b>Curly Collier</b>
Annual event sponsored by the San Diego area Kiwanis Clubs (called Division 100) - members lay quarters onto a concrete runway to illustrate the amount of collected in donations in relation to a mile of quarters. Funds raised for the hospital during the year are presented.

A sponsored two-mile stretch of Interstate-8 passing by Alpine - pick up trash thrown along the sides of the freeway.
